

Privacy Policy

La Mon Hotel & Country Club – Summer Scheme 2026

La Mon Hotel & Country Club (“La Mon”, “we”, “us”, “our”) is committed to protecting and respecting your personal data. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, and protect personal information provided in connection with our **2026 Summer Scheme**.

This policy should be read alongside the **La Mon Hotel & Country Club general Privacy Policy**, which applies to use of our website, online reservations, cookies, and wider hotel services.

1. Scope of This Policy

While La Mon Hotel & Country Club’s general website is not intended for use by persons under the age of 18, the Summer Scheme necessarily involves the processing of children’s personal data. All such information is provided directly by a **parent or legal guardian** and handled with appropriate consent and safeguards.

2. Information We Collect

Parent / Guardian Information

- Full name
- Postal address
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Emergency contact details

Child Information

- Child’s name
- Date of birth and age
- Details of sessions or activities booked
- Relevant medical, dietary, accessibility, or safeguarding information you choose to provide

Payment Information

- Records of payments made for the Summer Scheme

La Mon Hotel & Country Club does not store full debit or credit card details. Payments are processed securely via our approved third-party booking and payment providers.

3. How We Use This Information

We collect and use personal data only where necessary and for the following purposes:

- To administer registrations and manage attendance
- To ensure the health, safety, and welfare of participating children
- To communicate important information, including schedules, updates, or emergency notices
- For internal record keeping and operational planning
- Where consent has been provided, to inform you about future family-friendly events or activities at La Mon

Personal data is processed on the lawful bases of **contractual necessity, legal obligation, legitimate interests relating to child welfare and safety, and parental consent**, as applicable.

4. Marketing Communications

Where you have given consent, we may contact you with information relating to future family events or similar offerings at La Mon Hotel & Country Club.

You may opt out of marketing communications at any time by:

- Using the unsubscribe option in emails, or
- Contacting the hotel directly

5. Photography and Media Use

Photographs or video recordings may be taken during Summer Scheme activities for:

- Internal records
- Promotional use on La Mon Hotel & Country Club's website, social media channels, or printed materials

Parental or guardian consent will be obtained before any images of children are used for promotional purposes.

- Children will not be identified by name
- Group photographs may be used where no child is singled out
- Images will only be accessible to authorised staff

Parents or guardians may request access to images of their child or request removal from public platforms, which will be actioned promptly where reasonably possible.

6. Sharing of Personal Information

We do **not** sell, rent, or trade personal information.

Personal data may only be shared:

- Where required by law or regulatory authorities
- Where necessary for safeguarding or child-protection concerns

- With trusted service providers involved in administering the scheme, subject to confidentiality and data-protection agreements

7. Data Security

La Mon Hotel & Country Club implements appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data from unauthorised access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction.

Access to data is limited to staff who require the information to carry out their role in connection with the Summer Scheme.

8. Data Retention

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, including legal, accounting, or safeguarding obligations. Data is securely deleted or anonymised once no longer required.

9. Your Rights

Under data protection legislation, you have the right to:

- Request access to your personal data
- Request correction of inaccurate or incomplete information
- Request deletion of data where applicable
- Withdraw consent at any time
- Lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO)

10. Changes to This Policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time. Any changes will be published with a revised date, and continued participation in the 2026 Summer Scheme will be subject to the updated policy.
